WHEN A DISASTER HAPPENS

Follow these steps:

- 1. **Assess** your personal and family **situation**.
- 2. If you are not safe where you are, seek safety.
- 3. Tune to KIRO AM 710 or FM 97.3 on a battery powered radio to learn what authorities suggest.
- 4. **Connect** with your **neighbors** for mutual assistance.
- 5. For problems you and your neighbors CAN NOT resolve: fill out the Problem Report form and take it to your nearest Hub Site.

When the status of the problem changes take an Update Report form to the same Hub Site.

6. If you are able, volunteer your skills and/or resources at the nearest Hub Site.

When you and your immediate neighbors CAN NOT resolve a problem,

complete this page and take it to the nearest Hub Site.
