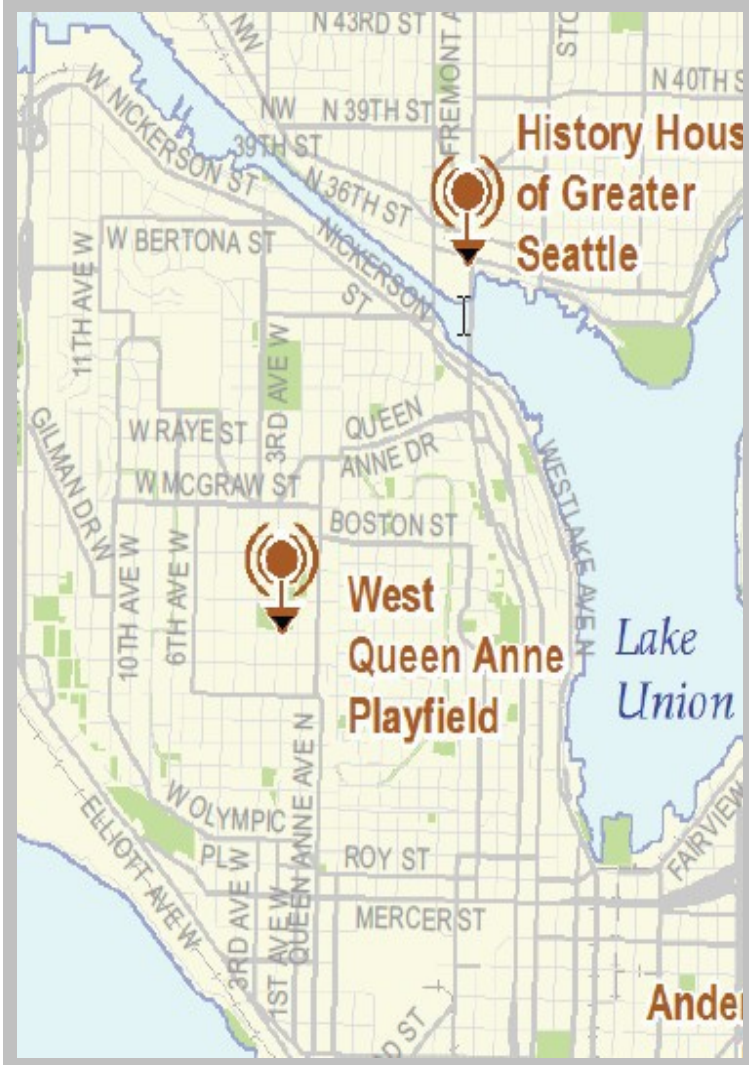


QUEEN ANNE / INTERBAY DISASTER RESPONSE PLAN

WHEN A DISASTER HAPPENS

Follow these steps:

1. **Assess** your personal and family **situation**.
2. If you are not safe where you are, **seek safety**.
3. **Tune** to KIRO AM 710 or FM 97.3 on a battery powered radio to learn what authorities suggest.
4. **Connect** with your **neighbors** for mutual assistance.
5. For problems you and your neighbors **CAN NOT** resolve: **fill out the Problem Report form and take it to your nearest Hub Site**.

When the status of the problem changes **take an Update Report form to the same Hub Site**.
6. If you are able, **volunteer your skills and/or resources** at the nearest Hub Site.

Be Aware:

WHEN AVAILABLE.**

When you and your immediate neighbors **CAN NOT** resolve a problem, **complete this page and take it to the nearest Hub Site.**

This assessment with no request for service.
